Speed:



a) Learner access

c. Based on different language skills


Including written and oral comprehension, oral expression, vocabulary, and grammar.

3. Work through three sections

- **c. Test:** mini-tests of three to six questions with corrections to check that course content has been learned (except for written and oral expression skills, where the Test part is replaced by a second training section: Practise 2).

b) Teacher access

Presentation of the interface

Teachers have access to the **TMS** (Teacher Management System), a customisable interface that meets the needs of both teachers and their students.

This rich tool lets teachers:

- Personalise their students' learning paths,
- Simply and efficiently manage the programmes,
- Monitor their students' progress,
- Evaluate each student's work,
- Communicate with students,
- Manage student/teacher access and create classes/groups,
- Create course content.
- Integrate specific modules in an activity sector (see Appendix 1).

Overview of content

A number of sections are available to the teacher:

Registration: create and register classes/groups, teachers and students.

Curriculum:

- **Course Builder:** the teacher can assign or delete lessons, activities and modules, and create and personalise lessons. This tool illustrates some of the personalisation capacities that **ED** offers.
- **Study Planner:** this tool automatically establishes a calendar for the student's path, defining the number of hours of study required each week to meet the goal.

Reports: the teacher can access various reports on student progress, test scores, connection times, and oral exercise recordings.

Assessment: contains numerous tests for each level.



Blended Learning

This model combines the use of the **ED** platform with educational content used in class.

1. ED content adapted and used with ED materials

Recommended for any organisation wanting a complete learning solution. We suggest adapting the content of the **ED** platform to your programme. Documents in PDF format (workbook, teacher's guide) are available to complete the content available on the platform and ensure continuity throughout the course.

2. ED content adapted and used to supplement your own materials






